During the summer there will be some activity happening on Church and Pine Streets. The borough has not received a start date as the publishing of the newsletter, but it will be soon. The electrical poles between Virgin Lane and Pine Street will be moved back into the community grounds approximately 20 feet. There will be curbing, sidewalk, and diagonal parking added between Virgin Lane and the flagpole. Church Street will then be repaired. Pine Street will also be under construction. As stated, we do not have a start date yet, but it will be taking place within the coming weeks. We are hoping that it will be finished before school begins in August.
