Key Dates for Upcoming Primary Election

The 2024 Primary Election is coming up on Tuesday, April 23.

If you are not already registered to vote, the deadline to do so is Monday, April 8. To register to vote you must be a United States citizen, a Pennsylvania resident for at least 30 days before the next election and age 18 before the next election. You may register in person at your county elections office, by mail or by visiting the state's online voter registration

website. The last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot is Tuesday, April 16, by 5 p.m. Completed ballots must be returned by 8 p.m. on Tuesday, April 23. For more information about voting in the Commonwealth, including how to check your registration, and voting location, visit www.vote.pa.gov.
